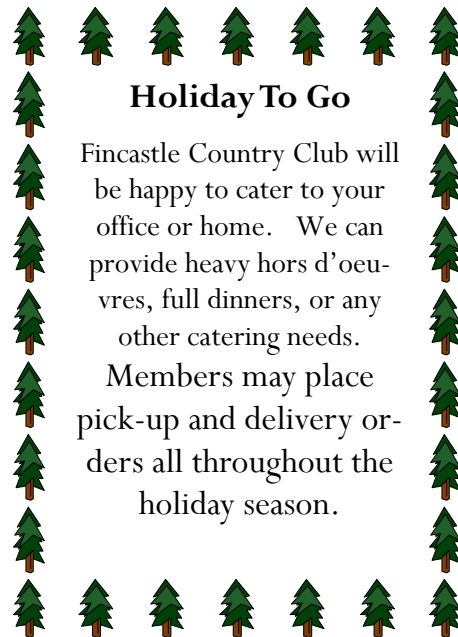
### Thanksgiving Day Packages To-Go
